**Presentation Time:** 50 minutes    **Set-Up :** 30 minutes minimum; 45 to 60 minutes preferred    **Take-Down:** 20 to 30 minutes

**Arrival:** 45 to 60 minutes before presentation time. No assistance needed beyond accessibility to performance area.

**Classroom Teacher Requirements:** Read and discuss chosen book prior to assembly date. During the assembly (and/or workshops), please join your students in the creative process!

**Technology Requirements:** We are able to bring our own sound system, or use the existing one in your assembly space.
